The Court of Audit sends its 28th Report with comments to the Parliament of the French Community



The 28th Report with comments that the Court of Audit sends to the Parliament of the French community is divided into two parts.

The first part contains accounting and budgetary articles. At first, it comments on the approval of general accounts of the French Community and of several depending public services and entities. It then deals with the specific account audits.

In the second part, the Court of Audit reminds of its comments and recommendations made during two audits. The first one focuses on the expenses of the secretariat and supporting services of the members of the French Community government members. The second deals with the administrative and financial status of the staff of the ICT company.
