The Court of Audit sends its 29th Report with comments to the Walloon Parliament




The 29th Report with comments that the Court of Audit sends to the Walloon Parliament is divided into two parts : the first focuses on the 2016 general account of the Walloon Region whereas the second covers the verification of the public services' accounts and several specific audits.

In the first part, the Court delivers its comments and recommendations on the 2016 accounts of the General Administration's services.

In the second part, the Court first comments the approval of the public services' general accounts submitted to the Court's inspection and the results of the accounts verification of some of them.

The Court then provides an analysis of the external inspection of the bodies that are part of the Walloon Region's consolidation perimeter as well as its own comments and recommendations on audits it has carried out in different sectors about various topics: the implementation and registration of missions delegated to Sowafinal in 2015 and 2016, the modifications of public roads and motorways contracts in the Walloon Region, the planning of investments for sport facilities and the draft budgets 2018 of the Walloon provinces.
