

Report to the federal Parliament National Health Services financial responsibility



On 22 October 2015, the federal Parliament adopted a resolution entrusting the Court of Audit with two audits regarding the national health service sector (on the one hand the compensation of the national health services administrative costs, on the other their financial responsibility). The parliament also requested the Court of Audit to perform a third audit concerning the federal public institutions supervising the national health services. In its resolution, the parliament requested the Court of Audit to report on those three audits in 2016, 2017 and 2018 respectively.

The Court of Audit has sent the second audit results (regarding the way national health services are held accountable for the health and disability insurance expenses) to the federal Parliament. The report was published on the Court of Audit website today.
